	<p><u>PC:</u> Fever</p> <p>Recent surgery on (R) knee (3/10/07)</p>	
	<p><u>HPC:</u> - On Sat 29/9/07 pt cut his (R) knee on glass whilst attending Oktoberfest in Munich, Germany</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pt attended to his own wound, keeping it clean &amp; returned to UK &amp; no significant problems</li> <li>- During the next week the pt's wound became pussy &amp; experienced reduced movement of his (R) knee</li> <li>- He was admitted to CXH on 3/10/07 for surgical debridement of his (R) knee wound (removal of glass)</li> <li>- He was discharged the following day &amp; felt generally well. He was sent home on a 4 day course of Augmentin 375mg tds.</li> <li>- On Fri 5/10/07 the pt began to feel unwell with fevers lasting a few hours, which came &amp; went. He felt shivery before the onset of the fevers, but did not c/o any sweating episodes.</li> <li>- The pt also experienced a sore throat &amp; developed a cough, which was generally unproductive.</li> <li>- o N+V, o diarrhoea, o urinary symptoms, o rashes/neckstiffness/photophobia</li> <li>- The pt reported no changes to his (R) knee.</li> <li>- No foreign travel, except to Germany, in past few months</li> <li>- In contact with one friend who has been ill, chest infection, but now well.</li> </ul>	

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


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

On examination his (R) knee was swollen and warmer compared to his (L) knee.
