This document provides instructions on how to submit your In-course Assessment using Blackboard.

BLACKBOARD LOGIN & TROUBLE-SHOOTING

Please log into Blackboard <http://learn.imperial.ac.uk/> and select the appropriate BSc Blackboard course to submit your In-course Assessments.

If you are experience any technical problems with submitting your essay, you should run a **Browser Check** to ensure that the browser you are using is configured correctly.

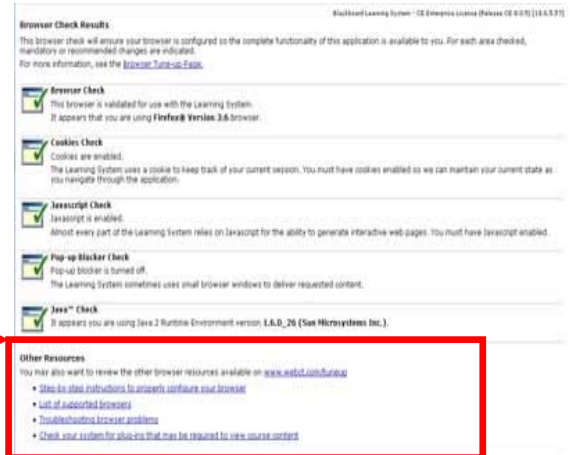
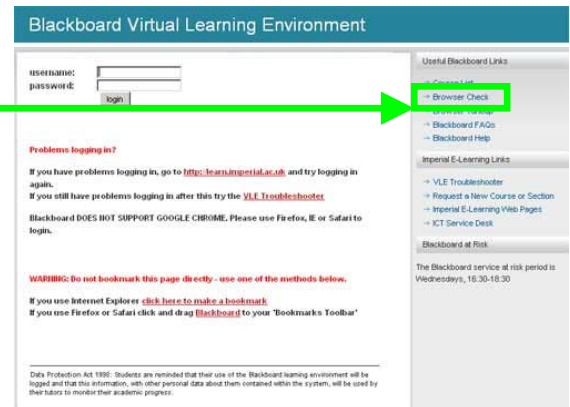
A pop-up window with open with the browser check results. If there is a problem with your browser's configuration, then this will be indicated with a red cross.

Other Resources and follow the instructions.

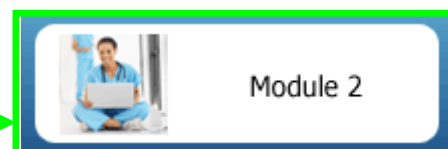
Please note that Blackboard is only compatible with Internet Explorer, **Firefox (recommended)** & Safari browsers.

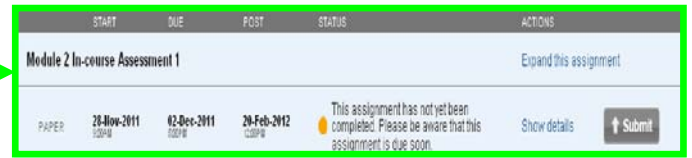
BLACKBOARD COURSE – SUBMITTING THE IN-COURSE ASSESSMENT

Once you have logged into Blackboard and selected your relevant BSc course, click on the **module folder**, from the homepage of the course.



Inside the folder you will see a link to submit your In-course Assessment.

Once you have selected the link you will be presented with a screen (as shown) providing the start date/time & due date/ time of the submission portal.



Click on '**Submit**' button. You are then be presented with two options:

Option 1	Select the single file upload from the 'choose a paper item submission method' drop-down menu.	<p>choose a paper submission method:</p> <p>single file upload</p>
	<p>Enter the submission title in the text box provided. Click on the browse button to upload a file.</p> <p>Once you have uploaded your document, click on the upload button.</p> <p>Please note a list of acceptable file formats are provided in the area in yellow (as shown).</p>	<p>submission title *</p> <p>Requirements for single file upload:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> File must be less than 20 MB The maximum paper length is 400 pages. File Types allowed: MS Word, WordPerfect, PostScript, PDF, HTML, RTF and plain text. <p>If your file exceeds 20 MB, read suggestions to meet requirements.</p> <p>browse for the file to upload *</p> <p>upload cancel go back</p>

Option 2	Select the Cut & Paste from the 'choose a paper item submission method' drop-down menu.	<p>choose a paper submission method:</p> <p>single file upload</p> <p>single file upload</p> <p>cut & paste upload</p>
	<p>Enter the submission title in the text box provided. Copy the text from a text document and paste it in the text box provided.</p> <p>Do not manually type an entire paper in the copy/paste field, as this could cause you to be timed-out, losing all the entered data.</p> <p>Once you copied the data into the box, click on the upload button.</p>	<p>submission title: *</p> <p>cut and paste your paper: *</p>

Once you have submitted successfully, you will get a digital receipt of your submission, as shown below.



Your submission is still being processed. This digital receipt is a record of your submission. When your submission is fully processed, it will only contain the text that you submitted.
