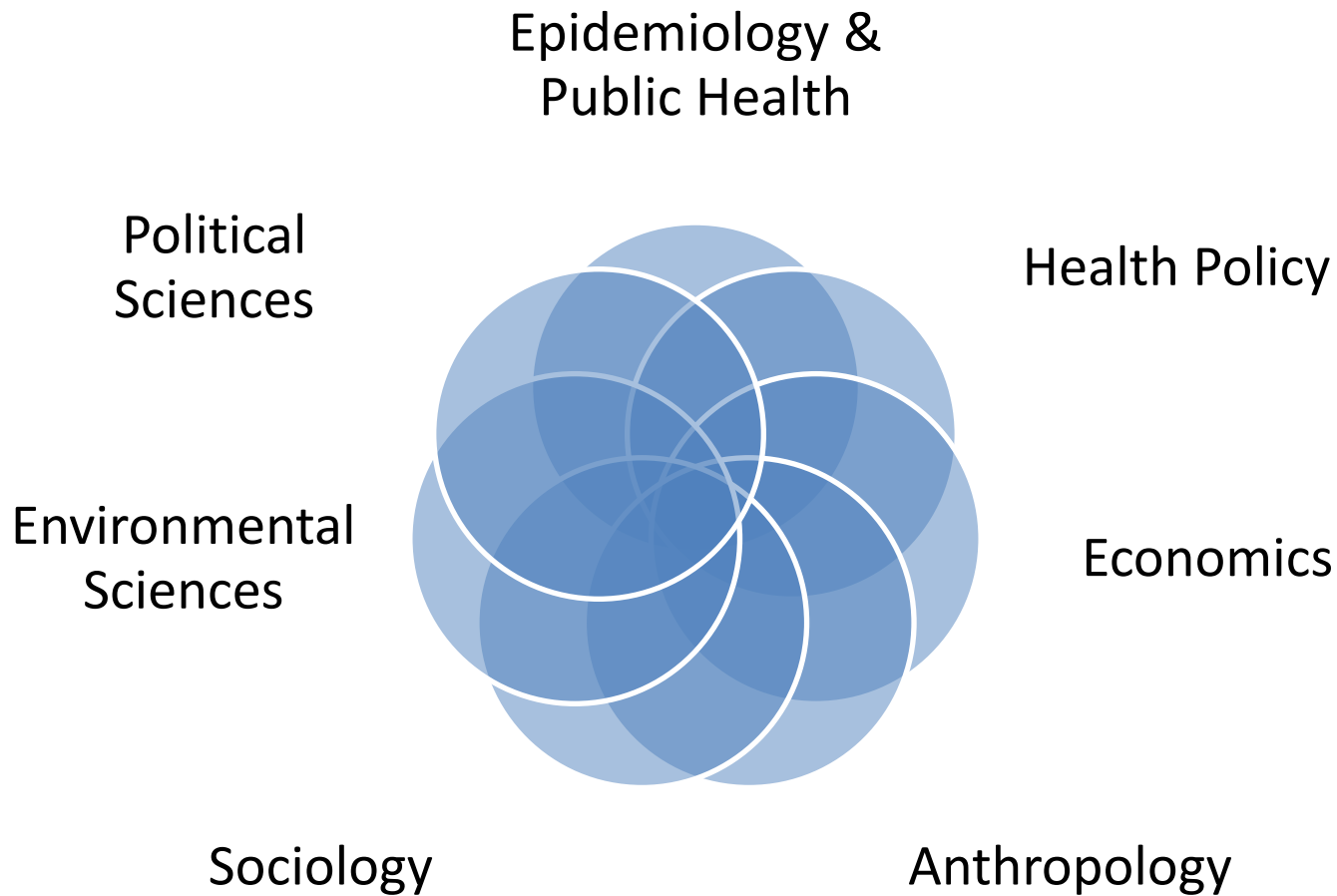

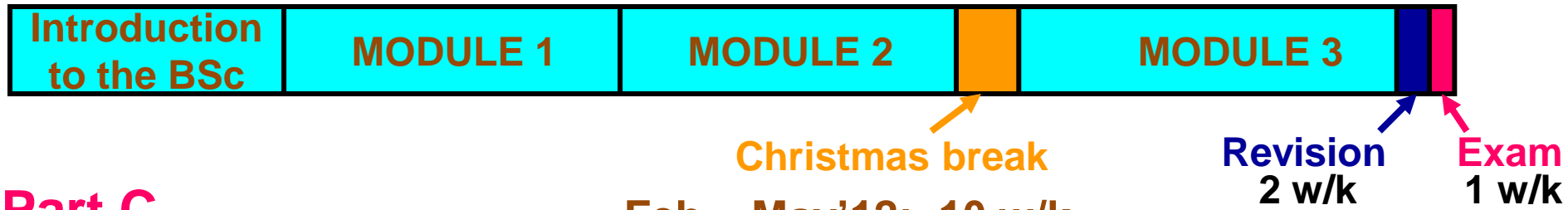
MAP OF THE 2011-12 BSc STRUCTURE

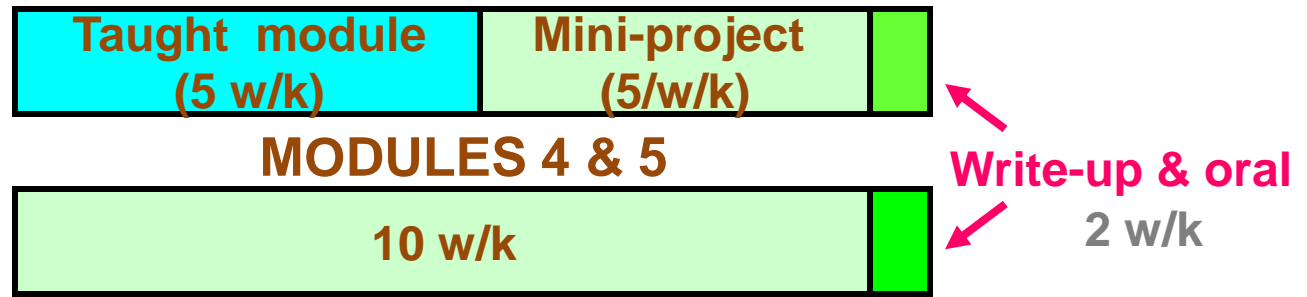

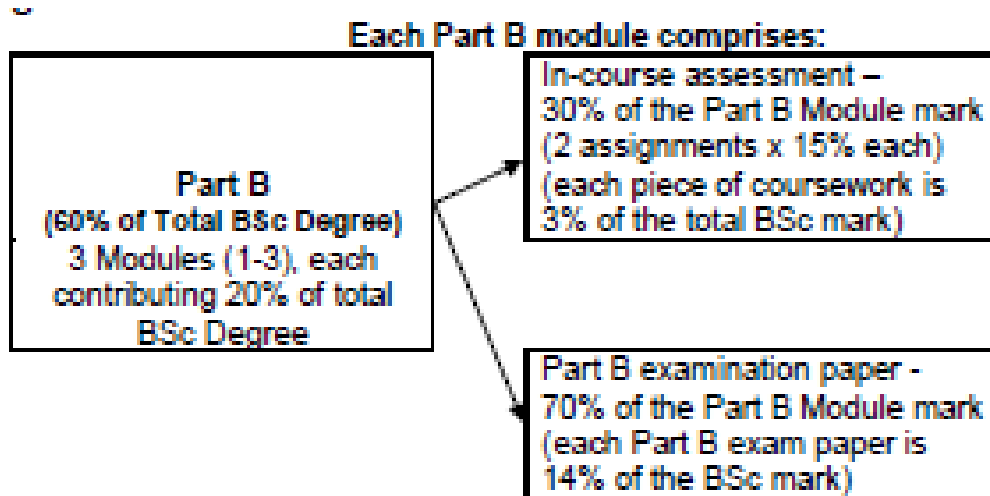

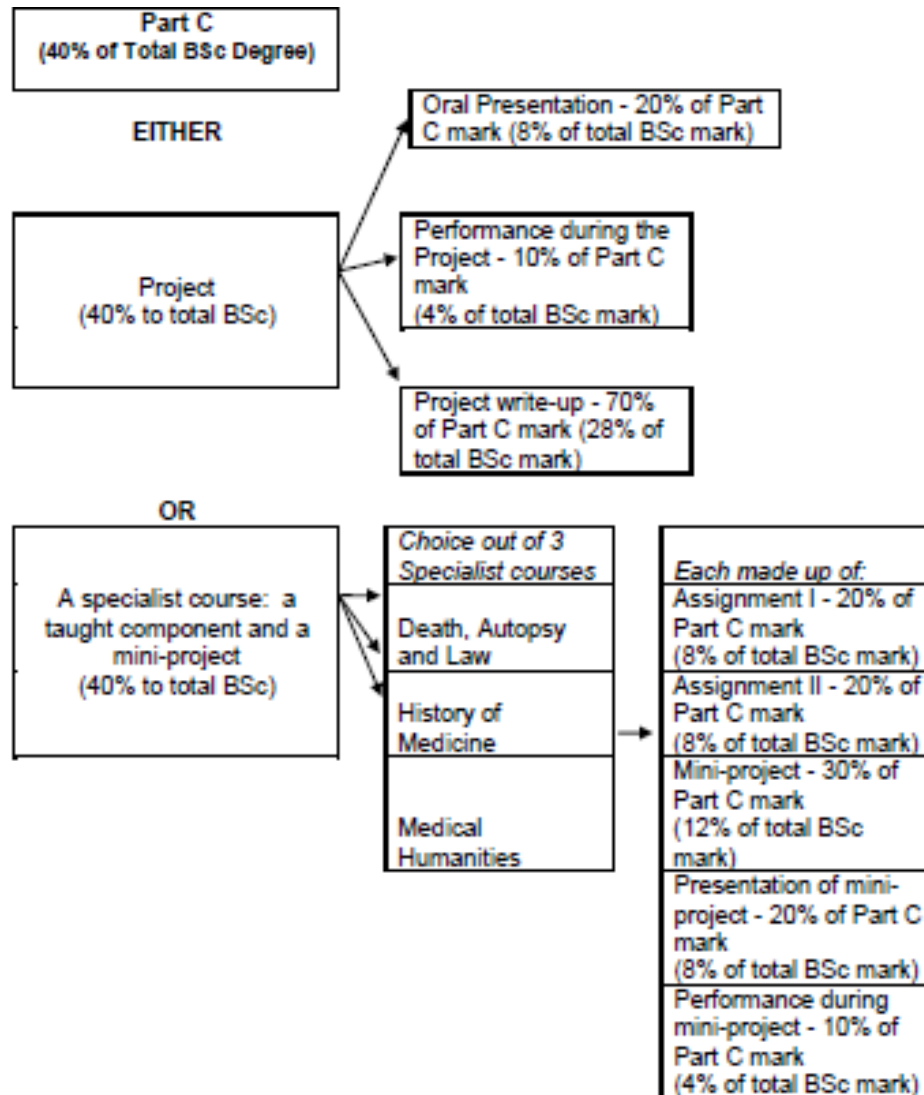
